

While the health system reorients to incentivise and support person-centred and sustainable care that focuses on outcomes over activity, and value over volume, health services are already demonstrating such shifts.





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
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Implementing value-based healthcare using a digital health exchange platform to improve pregnancy and childbirth outcomes in urban and rural Kenya

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Maternal and neonatal mortality rates in many low- and middle-income countries (LMICs) are still far above the targets of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goal 3. Value-based healthcare (VBHC) has the potential to outperform traditional supply-driven approaches in changing this dismal situation, and significantly improve maternal, neonatal and child health (MNCH) outcomes. We developed a theory of change and used a




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It takes two to dance the VBHC tango: A multiple case study of the adoption of value-based strategies in Sweden and Brazil

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ABSTRACT

Although Value-Based Health Care (VBHC) is widely debated and cited, there are few empirical studies focused on how its concepts are understood and applied in real-world contexts. This comparative case study of two prominent adopters in Brazil and Sweden, situated at either end of the spectrum in terms of contextual prerequisites, provides insights into the complex interactions involved in the adoption of value-based strategies. We found that the adoption of VBHC emphasized either health outcomes or costs – not both as suggested by the value equation. This may be linked to broader health system and societal contexts. Implementation can generate tensions with traditional business models, suggesting that providers should first analyze how these strategies align with their internal context. Adoption by a single provider organization is challenging, if not impossible. An





The Challenge

Manchester University NHS Foundation Trust is an NHS Acute Foundation Trust which operates 10 hospitals throughout Greater Manchester. It is the largest NHS trust in the United Kingdom, with an income of £1.6 billion and 21,945 staff.

The trust processes 93 parotid surgery cases per annum. A parotidectomy is the surgical removal of part or all of the parotid gland. The operation is performed under general anaesthetic. At the end of the operation the surgeon places a drain (plastic tube) through the skin in order to prevent any blood clot collecting under the skin.


Patients spend on average 2.5 nights in hospital. Working with the clinical and procurement teams at Manchester NHS FT, Baxter Healthcare successfully
